
WELCOME HOME!

ALUMNI OF THE YEAR

Betty Ann Howard, Ph.D

Dr. Betty Ann Howard rose from humble beginnings in Alabama through determination and hard work. She received her nursing degree from the University of Alabama and was a certified nurse anesthetist. She continued her education with a BS in Religious Education from Columbia Union College in 1970 and an MA in Education from Andrews University. In 1988 she received her doctoral degree in Higher Education Administration from the University of Maryland.

Dr. Howard served as the Dean of Women at Columbia Union College, from 1967 to 1970 and from 1979 to 1983. While serving as the Dean of Women at Columbia Union College, Howard became the first president of the newly incorporated Association of Adventist Women, Inc. (AAW) in 1982, first national AAW board and AAW conference.

In 1983, Howard became the acting Dean of Students at Columbia Union College. She developed program initiatives for students including counseling and support for new and foreign students. She also designed and directed an annual “Careers Day” recruiting speakers and organizing student workshops and panels. Together with Dr. Joseph Gurubatham, Howard applied for and received US government Title III and Title VII grants. To fund the college’s first computer laboratory, and enabling the college to provide tutorial services and assistance to students.

Counseling was one of Howard’s responsibilities. School-wide programs such as beginning-of-the-year orientations for new and foreign students were established. Howard developed the first English-as-a-Second Language (ESL) program for non-native speakers attending the college. Howard also directed the Summer Start program in which applicants not qualified for freshman status were required to pass summer courses consisting of study skills, mathematics, English, and reading.

In 1992, Howard joined the Department of Education. She taught Philosophy of Christian Education, Healthier Living, School Administration, and Study Skills. In addition to her teaching load, Howard maintained the standardized testing services for the Adult Evening Program, the day campus, and the community. She was the faculty sponsor for two national honor society chapters: Alpha Chi and Phi Eta Sigma.

It is our great honor to recognize Dr. Betty Ann Howard as the Alumni of the Year for her exemplary life, her contributions to the college and to the community, and for representing the best in Adventist womanhood.

ALUMNI OF THE YEAR

Lorenzo Grant

Pastor Lorenzo Grant, D.Min., earned his bachelor's degree from CUC in 1966, where he met and married his bride Grayce Nelson. The couple has three children and three grandchildren.

Pastor Grant began his long and distinguished professional life as executive director of human relations for the city of Erie, Pennsylvania. He later took a one-year program at Andrews University, and a field school of evangelism in California, to further prepare for ministry, returning to Maryland to work in the Allegheny Conference as a pastor and evangelist. While in Maryland, he earned his Master's in Education and his D.Min. from Howard University.

Dr. Grant has served his beloved church with distinction as an educator in Christian ethics and bioethics in Columbia Union College's Adult Evening Program, at Southern Adventist University, Pacific Union College's Los Angeles extension program at White Memorial Hospital, and at Florida Hospital College of Health Science, where he continues to teach.

Grant's career also has included successful work as youth director for the Columbia Union, a chaplain to Adventist youth at non-Adventist colleges, and a trust officer for the Allegheny East Conference. As pastor of the Breath of Life congregation he established a daycare center that led to a number of Bible studies and baptisms, and held what was one of the largest and most successful Revelation seminars of its time.

A move to Southern California took Grant to the University Church as pastor of the largest black church on the West Coast. He later became director of the African-American region with 22 churches throughout the Southern California Conference, and launched what became the Natural Church Development program. The Grants moved to Sebring, Florida, late in 2004, just in time to survive Hurricane Charley.

Grant says that one of the most valuable lessons he learned while at Columbia Union College that has carried him through his career was to possess a spirit of integrity and creativity, and maintain authenticity of self and faith in knowing that each individual is ultimately accountable to God.

It is our great honor to recognize Pastor Lorenzo Grant as the Alumni of the Year for his exemplary life of distinguished service to students, congregations, communities, and the Seventh-day Adventist Church.

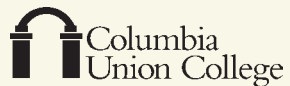
