Jeryl Cunningham, a native of New York, is a graduate of Oakwood College and of Mannes School of Music in New York. She is a doctor of music arts candidate at the University of Kentucky, with major emphasis in vocal performance. Her classification as a dramatic coloratura soprano is given based on her successful ability to sing the Queen of the Night role in Mozart's Magic Flute. This is one of the most demanding roles for coloraturas because of its tessitura which has several high "F's" above the soprano high "C." This separates her from the most common voice type of soprano voice which is the lyric soprano. Jeryl has performed many prominent operatic and oratorio roles throughout her young career. She is a member of the American Spiritual Ensemble based in Lexington, Kentucky.

Organist and pianist, **Lerie Dellosa**, resides in Baltimore, but is no stranger to Sligo Church. She holds degrees from Towson University in Baltimore, Strayer College, the University of Santo Tomas in Manila, Philippines, and Philippine Union College. Lerie is married to a medical doctor, Johnson, and together they together have an 8-year-old son, Kyle. Lerie will be serving as one of our artists-in-residence on both the organ and piano.
